



NEGOTIATIONS BREAK DOWN AGAIN STRIKE AUTHORIZATION VOTE SET

The Teamsters Sysco Boston Negotiating Team returned to the table this morning. Your team offered a comprehensive health care proposal that would provide Teamster healthcare to Sysco Teamsters (see plan description).

Instead of responding to the proposal, Sysco negotiators offered their own proposal concerning the placement of "Bulletin Boards." For the second consecutive day negotiations broke down due to management's stall and delay tactics.

Negotiations are not scheduled to resume until April 16. In the meantime, the company must be shown that Sysco Teamsters are serious about achieving a fair contract without repeated delays. A strike authorization vote will be held this Sunday, April 7 at the Local 653 Union Hall.

"The Teamsters will not tolerate the games Sysco is playing at the table," said Sean O'Brien, Teamsters International Vice President. "Management needs to get serious about the REAL issues and stop stalling. A strong message must be sent that Sysco Teamsters are serious and united."
